*Children must be residents of Keene, Marlborough, or Surry to participate in KCRBA programs*

**To be eligible, children must turn 4 years of age before April 30, 2012, and may not turn 13 years of age before April 30, 2012.**

***AGE determination is whatever a player's age is on April 30<sup>th</sup>- that is the player's "league age" for that season.***

Please note **all new players** must show an original or certified copy of birth certificates at registration.

Registration on February 4<sup>th</sup> is very important, since it allows us to begin the time-consuming process of preparing for tryouts and planning the number of teams for each level of play, ensuring your child has the best opportunity to enjoy baseball.

***Fundraising Packets and information on tryout dates, times, and locations will also be distributed at the time of registration.***

**Draft rule notifications:**

A child drafted for a Senior or Junior League team who elects to remain at a lower level is not eligible for KCRBA All-Star selection. The child remains eligible to play in KCRBA's Summer League.

**2012 Registration Fees**

- **\$45** T-ball (4-5 (some 6) year olds who have not played before)
- **\$60** Individual (6-12 year olds, PeeWee through Sr. league)
- **\$75** T-ball Family (one T-ball player and one PeeWee – Senior League player)
- **\$90** Family (more than one player from same household, PeeWee-Senior league)

*Financial Assistance and Player Scholarships are available as one of the goals of KCRBA is that all players that want to play be given the opportunity to participate whether they can afford it or not.*

**Each Player is required to participate in a League Wide Raffle Fundraiser; Players have the option of a one- time buyout, if they do not wish to participate.**

***Buyouts will not be available once player has received fundraising packet.***

***\*Those parents who wish to coach in the 2012 Season must have completed the online ASEP coaching certification but will be credited for the cost of the program towards their child's registration costs.***

For those not able to attend our first registration may register at our second registration on February 15, 2012 from 5-8 or at Skills Assessment and Tryouts on March 10<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup>.
