

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE SCHOOL WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the school district in the Town of Chesterfield qualified to vote in District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Chesterfield Elementary School in said District on the 6th day of March, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. to act upon the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To hear the reports of agents, auditors, committees or officers chosen, and pass any vote relating thereto.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the district will vote to raise and appropriate the budget committee's recommended amount of \$8,336,993 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for the school district officials and agents, and for the payment for the statutory obligations of the district. The school board recommends \$8,336,993.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the District will vote to appropriate and authorize the School Board to transfer up to \$100,000 of its unencumbered funds, if any remain on hand at the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2010, to be deposited in the Capital Reserve Fund established by voters on March 5, 1994, for the purpose of major renovation/reconstruction of the school buildings and related costs, or to take any other action in relation thereto. (This article is recommended by the Chesterfield School Board and the Chesterfield Budget Committee.)

ARTICLE 4: To see if the voters of the Chesterfield School District will vote to direct the Chesterfield School Board to support any and all efforts of the New Hampshire School Boards Association to seek legislative repeal of RSA 273-A:12, Section VII., the provision in statute commonly referred to as the statutory "Evergreen Clause", to restore local control in the collective bargaining and school district budget processes.

ARTICLE 5: To transact any other business, that may legally come before this meeting.
