

Program Fees Information

A \$270 membership fee (\$30 per month) per child covers the school year regardless of how many days of the week or weeks of the year participants choose to attend. Payment plans are available.

A sliding fee scale, based on household size and income, is available to qualifying families and may reduce the fee to as little as \$108 per year (\$12 per month).



In addition, as a license-exempt child care provider, MANY Options accepts NH State Department of Health and Human Services Child Care Funds for those who qualify.

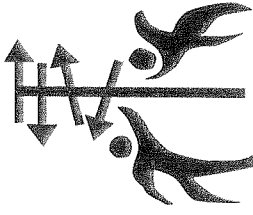
A limited number of full scholarships are available. We encourage you to call us at 355-3040, Ext. 108, for availability.

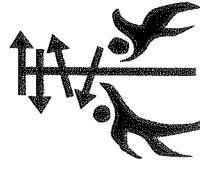

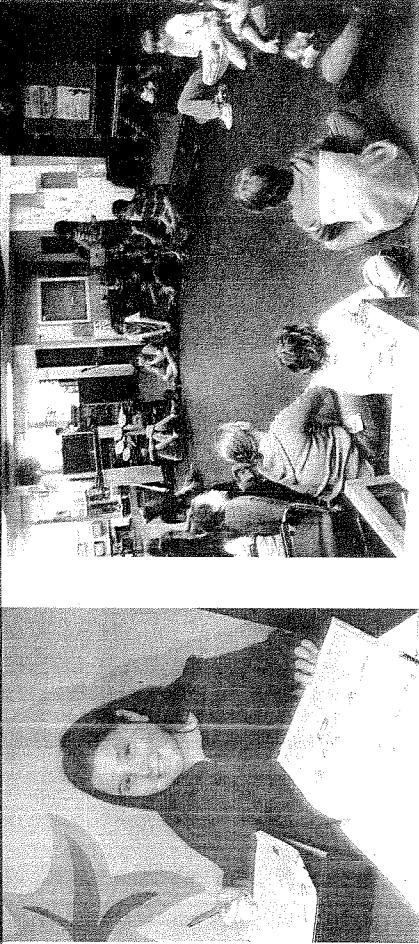
Where is MANY Options located?
