

**KEENE SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY IHCD - ADVANCED
COURSE WORK/ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSES**

Category P

Any student who is capable of and wishes to do advanced course work or take advanced placement classes while in high school should be permitted to do so. School district administrators and guidance counselors will provide assistance to students who wish to enroll in such courses. If advanced course work or advanced placement courses are not available within the school district, administrators or guidance counselors are instructed to assist students in identifying alternative means of taking such classes. This means may include taking courses at the virtual high school, in advanced placement or post secondary schools or other suitable means. Advanced placement students shall be required to take a test at the end of the course.

Any student whose eligibility for taking advanced course work is recommended by his/her counselor is eligible to enroll in a course. Credit may be given, provided the course comports with applicable District policies and state standards. The District will not be responsible for any tuition, fees, or other associated costs incurred by the student for enrollment in such courses.
