### **KSD Second Session Vote Set**

**Keene, NH ...** The Keene School District's proposed \$61.6 million budget, four-year agreements with school district school psychologists and speech pathologists, office personnel and custodians and three-year agreements with the district's principals, supervisors and tutors, and permission to sell the empty SAU building on West Street will be presented to the voters on Tuesday, March 13, 2012. Voters will also be asked to elect three members to the Keene Board of Education and a district clerk.

Polls are open from 7:30 a.m. until 7 p.m. Wards 1, 2 & 3 vote at the Keene Recreation Center at 312 Washington Street; and Wards 4 & 5 vote at the First Baptist Church, 105 Maple Avenue, next to the bypass.

All registered voters are eligible to vote. Same day registration is available to Keene residents who are eighteen years of age as of March 13, 2012. To register at the polls, you must show proof of age and a Keene street address. A driver's license is an appropriate ID.

For those voters unable to go to the polls to vote on Tuesday, March 13, 2012, absentee ballot applications may be obtained at the offices of the Keene School District, 193 Maple Avenue, each business day through March 12, 2012 from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. An application may be picked up and left at 193 Maple Avenue in the superintendent's office. An application must be filled out before a ballot will be released. A voter may also submit a request in writing, as long as a signature is included. No e-mail requests will be accepted. Only registered Keene voters will be able to vote by absentee ballot. Ballots may be hand delivered by the voter to the superintendent's office no later than 4:30 p.m. on March 12, 2012. Mailed ballots must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Election Day, March 13, 2012. If you have any questions, please call Diane Freitas in the superintendent's office at 357-9002 ext. 223.
