Keene, NH ... The Keene City Clerk's office has set a special evening session on Tuesday, January 31, 2012 from 7 – 7:30 p.m. for those who would like to register to vote at the Keene School District's First Session of its Annual District Meeting. This is the last time to register to be able to attend and vote at the First Session, which will be held on Saturday, February 11, 2012, at 9 a.m. in the auditorium at Keene High School. It is at that meeting that those in attendance may amend the proposed budget. By state law, there is no same day voter registration.

To register, you must have identification showing your age and street address. Keene residents may register anytime now through January 31, 2012, at the City Clerk's office, 3 Washington Street, Keene, from 8 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Following the First Session, the proposed budget and labor agreements will be presented at the polls to the voters at the Second Session of the Keene School District's Annual Meeting on March 13, 2012. Wards 1, 2, & 3 will vote at the Keene Recreation Center at 312 Washington Street; and Wards 4 & 5 at the First Baptist Church, 105 Maple Avenue, Keene. Polls will be open from 7:30 a.m. until 7 p.m. Same-day voter registration will be available.
