

STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE SCHOOL WARRANT

To the inhabitants of the school district in the Town of Westmoreland qualified to vote in District affairs:

You are hereby notified to meet at the Westmoreland School Gymnasium in said district on the 12th day of March, 2010, at 7:00 O'clock in the evening to act upon the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$250,000 for the renovation of the original wing of the Westmoreland School including fire safety renovations of the building's insulation envelope encompassing insulation, wiring, ceilings and lighting, flooring replacement, asbestos abatement, replacement of existing windows, and required fire door replacement, and related costs, and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$215,000 of bonds or notes in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA Chapter 33) and to authorize the school board to issue and negotiate such bonds or notes, and also to determine the rate of interest thereon; furthermore to authorize the withdrawal of \$35,000 from the District's Capital Reserve Fund established by voters on March 16, 2001 for such a purpose; or to take any other action in relation thereto. *(The Westmoreland Budget Committee and School Board support favorable action on this warrant article.) (2/3 ballot vote required)*

ARTICLE 2: To hear the reports of agents, auditors, committees, or officers chosen, and to pass any vote relating thereto.

ARTICLE 3: To see if the district will vote to raise and appropriate the budget committee's recommended amount of \$3,045,652 for the support of schools, for the payment of salaries for the school district officials and agents, and for the payment for the statutory obligations of the district. The school board recommends \$3,045,652.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the District will vote to appropriate and authorize the school board to transfer up to Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000) of its unencumbered funds, if any remain on hand at the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2010 to be deposited in the Capital Reserve Fund established by the voters of the District on March 16, 2001, for the purpose of major renovation/reconstruction of school buildings and related costs, or to take any other action in relation thereto. *(The Westmoreland Budget Committee and School Board support favorable action on this warrant article.)*

ARTICLE 5: To transact any other business that may legally come before the meeting.
